BIG TRUTH

God is Glorious. He shows His greatness and His worth.

NOTE TO PARENTS

This year, we are going to use our Timeline to walk through God's Big Story in the Bible.
This is the story of God and His people. It is the story of God rescuing His children and making a way for them to be with Him forever. It is the story that makes up the whole Bible.
The Bible is one book made up of hundreds of stories that all point to who God is and what He has done.

As we walk through God's Big Story this year, we will learn some of God's attributes. An attribute is a word that tells us what someone or something is like. God tells us who He is and what He is like in the Bible, His true Word. Every story, person, place, and event in the Bible is true. Each week we will learn stories about God, and these stories will show us who God is.



TIME

Centering the home on God's Word

After this week's lesson, ask:

- 1. We are learning about the attributes of God. What is an attribute? A word that tells what someone or something is like.
- 2. What attribute of God did you learn about today? *God is glorious*.
- 3. What does it mean for God to be Glorious? He shows His greatness and worth.
- 4. When humans show God's greatness and worth, that means we glorify Him. What are ways that we glorify God? We show and enjoy God as most valuable. We do that by the way we talk about Him and how we live our lives.
- 5. How does knowing that God is glorious help us to worship Him? We can see His greatness and worth in His creation and in reading His Word. We respond by giving Him glory for who He is and what He has done!

Read Hebrews 1:3 as a family. Talk about which testament, book, chapter, and verse this passage is found in.

- What words in this passage do you not recognize or understand?
 Radiance light or reflection
 Purification making clean
- 2. Who are these verses talking about? Jesus
- 3. What do we learn about Jesus' nature and character in these verses? This verse is showing us that Jesus is God. He reflects the glory of God the Father and is exactly like Him. He upholds the universe by the power of His word. He is seated at the right hand of the Father, so He is ruling with God the Father.
- 4. How can we show God's greatness to those around us?
- 5. As a family, how can we encourage one another to glorify God in how we care for others?
- 6. As a family, how can we remind one another that God is glorious and worthy of our worship?

Spend time reading the following verses:

Psalm 145:5–13

Isaiah 6:3

Psalm 24:7–8



MOMENTS

Proclaiming the truth as you go

- Wake up early to see the sunrise as a family. Talk about the beauty of the light that comes up everyday and how the sun reminds us of God's glorious nature.
- Sing songs of worship in the car on the way to school. We glorify God by showing and enjoying God as most valuable. Singing songs glorifies Him.
- If your kids are often honoring material things more than God, talk about how those things compare to God.
- Create a painting that highlights the stars in the night sky. Talk about how God's creation reveals His glory.

PRAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY Praise God that He is Glorious! Thank Him for showing His greatness and worth through His creation and His Word. Confess that we are easily distracted by other things that we think are valuable. Ask Him to help you to enjoy Him as most valuable and to glorify Him in all that you do.
