Family Worship Guide

We know this season will look unique for you as a family. Our hope is that it will be a formative and fruitful time as you worship alongside your children on Sunday mornings. Here is a guide that we pray is helpful:

Sing together

- Preschool Songs
- Elementary Songs

Break up the sermon into smaller chunks

- Depending on the age of your children, they may only be able to listen to 10-minute chunks of the sermon at a time.
- Based off of the sermon text for the week, have your children draw different aspects that
 are being talked about. Kids who are able to read and write can use the <u>Sermon Notes</u>
 <u>for Kids</u> as a guide. Use the <u>Family Discipleship Glossary</u> to help explain words that are
 unfamiliar in the text.

Talk about an attribute of God you heard in the sermon. Kids Village Attribute Posters.

Talk about a foundational truth you learned in the sermon

- God is Good
- God is in Charge of Everything
- God Wants to Talk With Us
- Jesus Came to Save Sinners
- God Made Everything

Memorize Scripture together

- Memory Verse Songs
- Memory Verse Calendar

Pray together. Talk through the parts of prayer as a family:

- Confession: is telling the truth about your sin
- Praise: is telling God how great He is
- Request: is asking God for something
- Thanksgiving: is thanking God for what He does and gives
