

Family Take-Home Sheet Jesus & the Woman at the Well John 4

Jesus was traveling from one city to another. To get there, Jesus had to walk through a place called Samaria. Jews, like Jesus, often went around Samaria because they did not like the people of Samaria! They went out of their way and walked all the way around Samaria instead. The Jews thought they were better than the Samaritans. They did not want to be around Samaritans, and they definitely did not talk to them! But Jesus was different.

Jesus walked through Samaria and stopped to rest at a well. A well is a deep hole in the ground where people got water. Back then, you could not get water from the sink or bathtub in your house. Everyone went to the well to get water. A woman from Samaria came to the well to get water.

When the woman came to the well, Jesus asked her to give Him some water. The woman was so surprised that Jesus spoke to her. She knew that Jesus was a Jew and Jews did not talk to Samaritans. She did not know that Jesus was the Son of God or that **Jesus Came to Save Sinners!**

The woman at the well had a heart sick with sin. Jesus told her He knew all about her sin. Jesus knew all about her because Jesus is God. Jesus came to earth to save the woman from her sins. **Jesus Came to Save Sinners!** Jesus told the woman that He was the Messiah who had come to save sinners and give them life with God forever. **The woman said to him, "I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ). When he comes, he will tell us all things." Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am he." John 4:25-26**

The woman believed Jesus and ran to tell others in Samaria that she had met Jesus! Many people believed her and they came to talk with Jesus. They knew they were all sinners and that **Jesus Came to Save Sinners!**

We are all born with hearts that are sick with sin. We all need Jesus. **Jesus Came to Save Sinners!** He came to give healthy hearts to everyone who loves and trusts Him and to help them fight sin. - 1. Where was Jesus when He stopped at the well? (Samaria)
- 2. Did Jews talk to Samaritans? (NO!)
- 3. Jesus told the woman two things. What did He tell her? (Jesus told her all about her life and that He came to save sinners!)
- 4. Did the woman believe Jesus? (Yes!)
- 5. What did the woman do next? (She ran to tell everyone that she had met the Savior!)
- 6. Did the people believe her? (Yes. They came to talk to Jesus and believed that He is the Savior!)
- 7. Jesus Came to Save Sinners! He did not just come for Jews or people who look like us. Jesus came to save all who would believe in Him!
